Certificate IV in Racing (Jockey)

The Certificate IV in Racing (Jockey) RGR40202 is an accredited training program for apprentice jockeys. Apprentices who successfully complete this course will have developed the skills and underpinning knowledge to become an independent professional jockey. They will have achieved competence in a range of areas that will enable them to:

- Perform high level riding
- Handle horse safely and confidently
- Gain knowledge of industry rules and regulations
- Identify, analyse and evaluate information from variety of sources
- Provide performance and fitness feedback of the horse to trainers and owners
- Exhibit a high degree of decision-making skill

Program Content

Apprentices need to complete the following 14 of units for the qualification:

Program Delivery Options

This program is best delivered to a small group in a classroom environment at Racing Victoria Ltd premises and on the job training at a thoroughbred racing stable. This will allow for a consistent approach to the delivery of learning as well as give the apprentices the opportunity to share ideas and experiences.

Mutual Recognition

Racing Victoria Ltd recognises AQF Qualifications and Statements of Attainment issued by other RTOs under our 'Mutual Recognition' obligation. Originals of any AQF Qualifications or Statements of Attainment will need to be sighted prior to enrolment so that any exemptions can be identified and granted (in accordance with RVLETC's Credit Transfer and RPL/RCC policies and procedures).



Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Participants who already possess the required knowledge and skills within specific units of competency (regardless of where or how these were acquired) may apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Participants who apply for RPL will need to provide evidence of their competence. Successful RPL applications will lead to exemptions from the identified unit/s of competency.

Entry requirements

Participants will need to demonstrate that they have the requisite English language, literacy and numeracy skills to be equivalent to level 3 of the National Reporting System as well as the ability to analyse and solve problems.

Certification

Participants who successfully complete the program of study will be issued with a Certificate IV in Racing (Jockey).
