



2020 COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR WALK ON MARES

Under the current State Government Stage 3 COVID-19 Restrictions Spendthrift Australia have been categorized as an essential business and continues to operate under a strict COVID-19 Policy.

The following measures have been implemented for the 2020 Breeding Season for visitors (including mare owners, walk on farm owners/employees and float drivers) accompanying mares walking on to our stallions:

- All visitors are expected to adhere to all current state and relevant local government area restrictions.
- Hand sanitizer is provided at the entry and exit points to our property and must be used before and after you have pressed the gate button.
- Visitors must scan the displayed QR code at the gate upon entering the property. If you have issues with logging in, please advise staff and we can log you in at the unloading area.
- Visitors are to remain in their vehicles. You must remain in your vehicle until the mare has been bred and is returned to your care.
- Walk on's are by appointment only and visitors must wear a mask at all times and adhere to social distancing.
- Strictly no access to the mare crush or covering shed.
- Mares that are dropped off early to be collected later in the day or the next day must be organised with the office prior to delivery. Drop offs and pick-ups must also be done in daylight hours as we do not have lighting in the area.
- Travel permits, if required, are to be organised by the visitor.
- Tea, coffee and bathroom facilities will not be available until further notice.

We will update you with any variations to this protocol throughout the season, if and when, state and local government area restrictions are changed.
