## 2020 Breeding Season COVID-19 Protocols

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, Blue Gum Farm has implemented the following guidelines for the upcoming breeding season for the safety of all staff and visitors and to ensure our stallions continue to cover during this pandemic.

- There will be a mandatory sign in book at the walk-in loading ramp located next to the office. All transport drivers and/or farm personnel are required to sign in before unloading your mare.
- Hand Sanitizer and disinfectant will be available at the loading ramps and must be used prior to unloading your mare.
- Mares are to be unloaded into one of the walk-in yards behind the office. We ask that halters and leads are removed and kept on your person.
- Once unloaded, drivers and/or farm personnel must return to their vehicles until your mare is covered and ready to depart.
- Once covered, a senior member of staff will advise you that your mare has been covered and can be collected from a walk-in yard with your halter and lead.
- Please keep contact with Blue Gum Farm staff to a minimum, respecting social distancing, wearing face coverings, and adhering to any other current COVID-19 government regulations.
- Unfortunately, Blue Gum Farm will not be able to offer bathroom facilities while restrictions are in place.
- Please allow extra travel time to ensure that you arrive to your cover on time.
- Any arrangement differing from the above protocols, please contact our office.
- **Stay informed-** The COVID-19 situation is constantly changing and evolving, which means it is important to stay informed. You can ensure this by monitoring the relevant Government websites and reading the TBV updates.
